

STATE OF MENTAL HEALTH IN INDIANA*

INDIANA RANKS **42** OUT OF 51 (INCLUDING DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA) INDICATING A HIGHER PREVALENCE OF MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE USE ISSUES

51.5% OF YOUTH EXPERIENCING MAJOR DEPRESSION CONTINUE TO GO UNTREATED

26.8% OF ADULTS WITH MENTAL ILLNESS REPORTED THEY WERE NOT ABLE TO RECEIVE THE TREATMENT THEY NEEDED BECAUSE OF BARRIERS THEY WERE FACING

5.6% OF ADULTS IN INDIANA REPORT SERIOUS THOUGHTS OF SUICIDE

8.4% OF ADULTS REPORT HAVING A SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER IN THE PAST YEAR

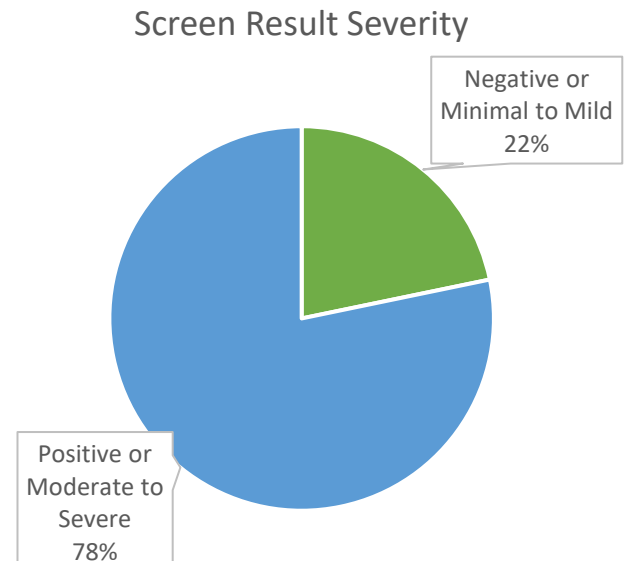
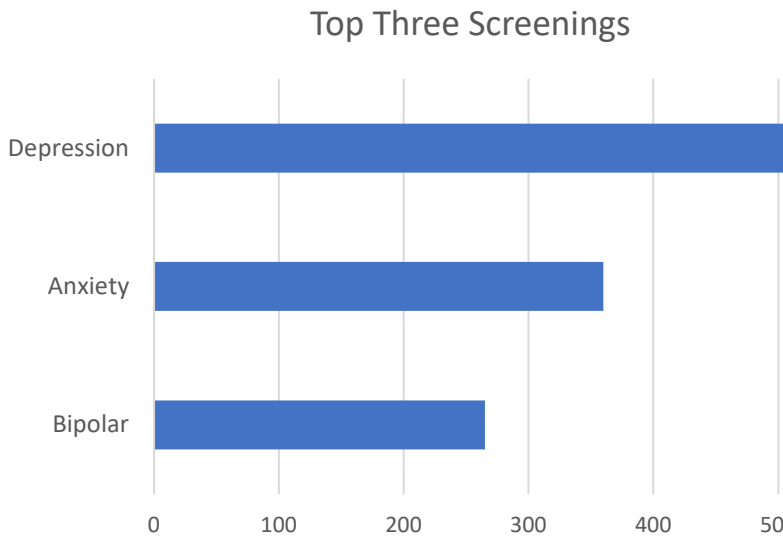
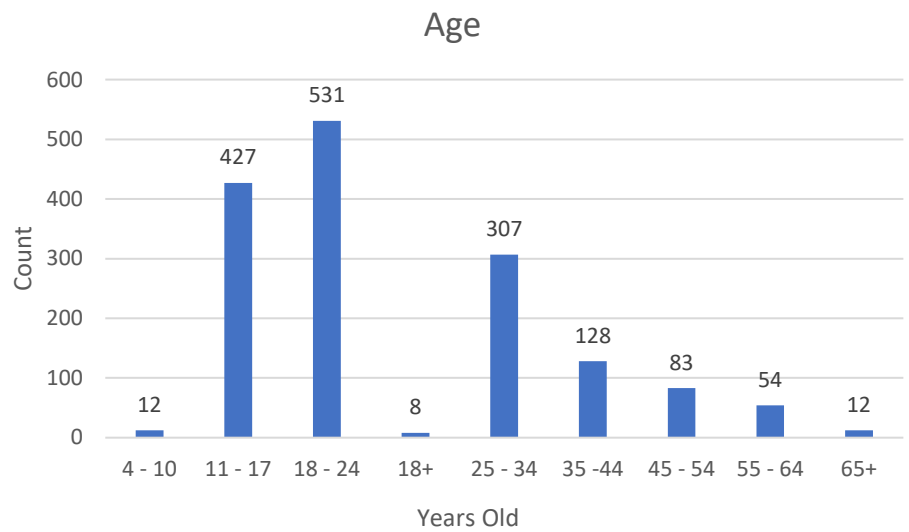
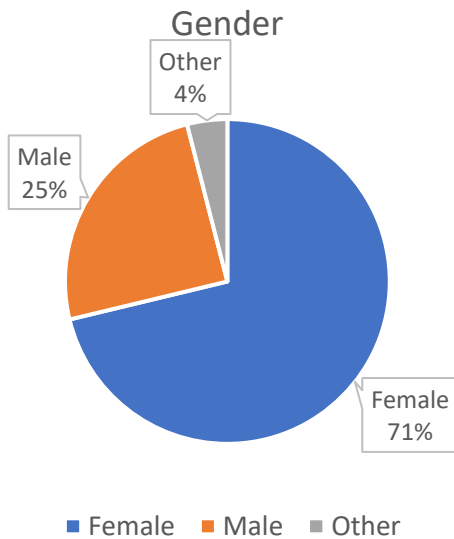
12,200 CRISIS CENTER CALLS ANSWERED AN INCREASE OF 87.7% DURING THE SAME TIME LAST YEAR

105 PEOPLE HAVE STARTED ON THEIR PATH TO RECOVERY THROUGH THE LET'S TALK PROGRAM

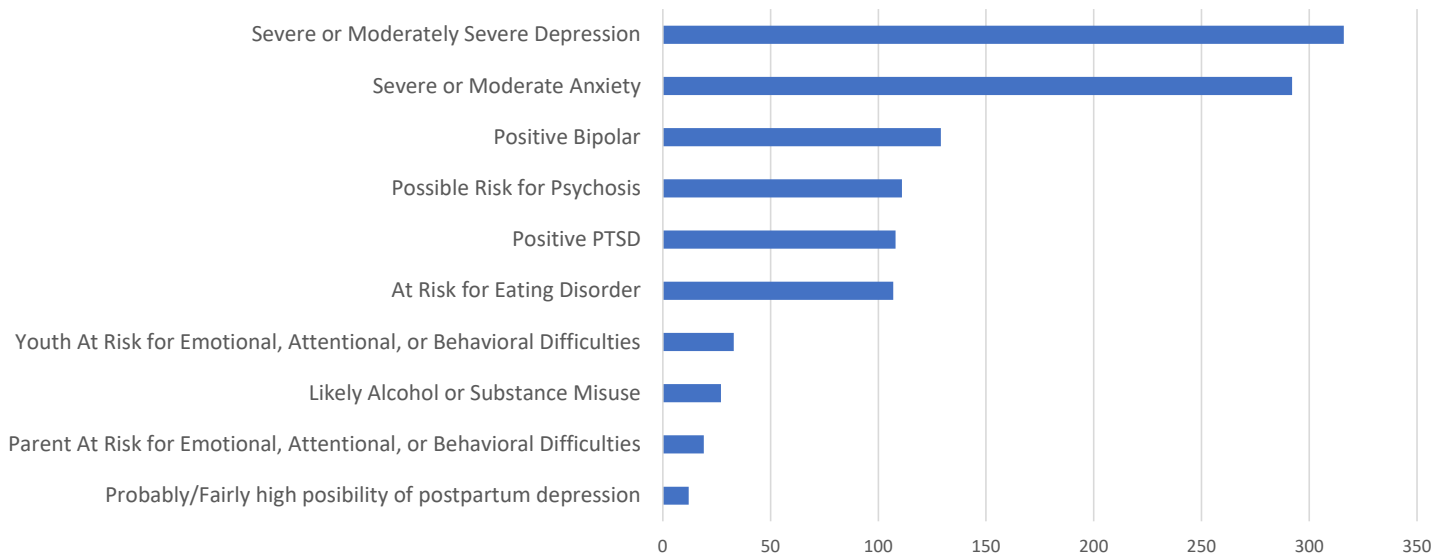
